JAIAH WALLACE

Riverview celebrates Jaiah Wallace for his Extension Two English major work which will be published in the prestigious publication, Young Writers Showcase (2024). Jaiah's 6000-word fictional piece titled *Mangarrayi* is an appropriation and reimagining of Jeannie Gunn's colonial work. In challenging past depictions of First Nations people, Jaiah's narrative reflects his commitment to decolonising the Australian literary canon, using literature to represent marginalised voices. In Jaiah's words, *Mangarrayi* contributes "to the ongoing dialogue around truth-telling in Australia, continuously striving for an authentically reconciled future".



CHRIS SWAN

In 2024, Chris Swan – a young Indigenous student hailing from Moree – received the Academic Excellence Award from Yalari, acknowledging his outstanding commitment to his education throughout his schooling journey. Chris won this singular distinction among all of the First Nations graduates in the Yalari program across New South Wales.



GEORGE GAHA

George Gaha's Visual Arts Body of Work, titled *Meditations on Conflict: Asceticism and Hedonism*, selected for ARTEXPRESS consists of seven large charcoal and graphite drawings on paper. The work explores the tension of opposites: strict discipline and raw pleasure, good and evil, light and dark. The dark black caves made of charcoal contain the light seen in the flowing white water. The figures drawn in graphite are reaching, struggling for a deeper truth—for heaven. George took inspiration from Michelangelo, Caravaggio, James Gleeson and Bill Henson.

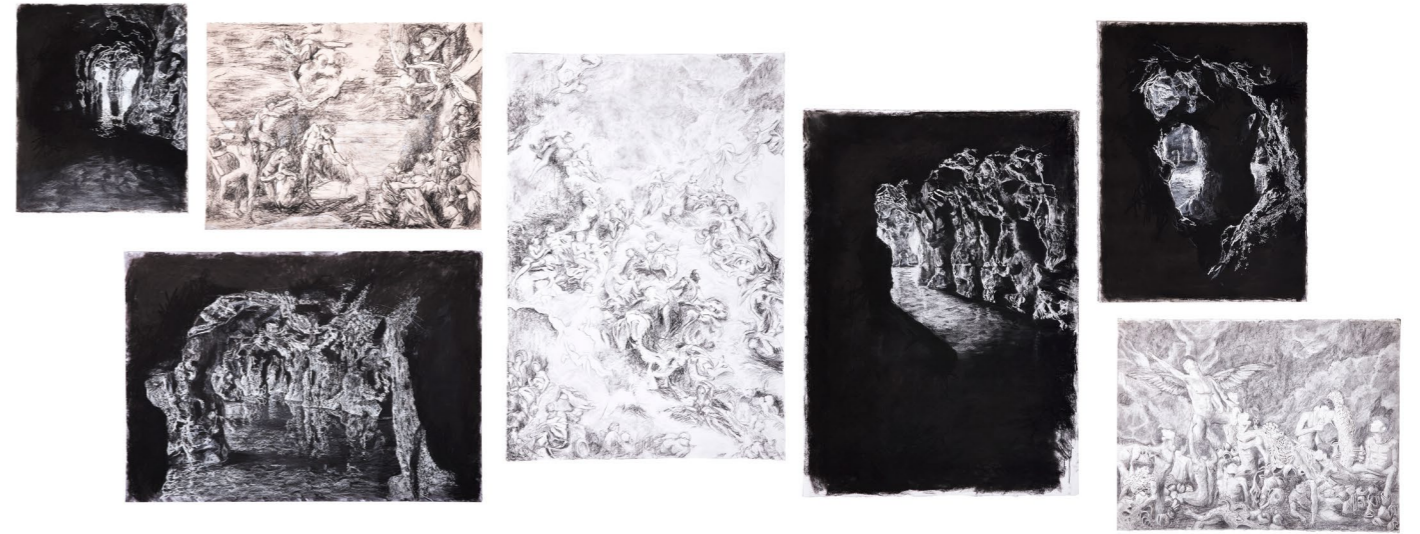

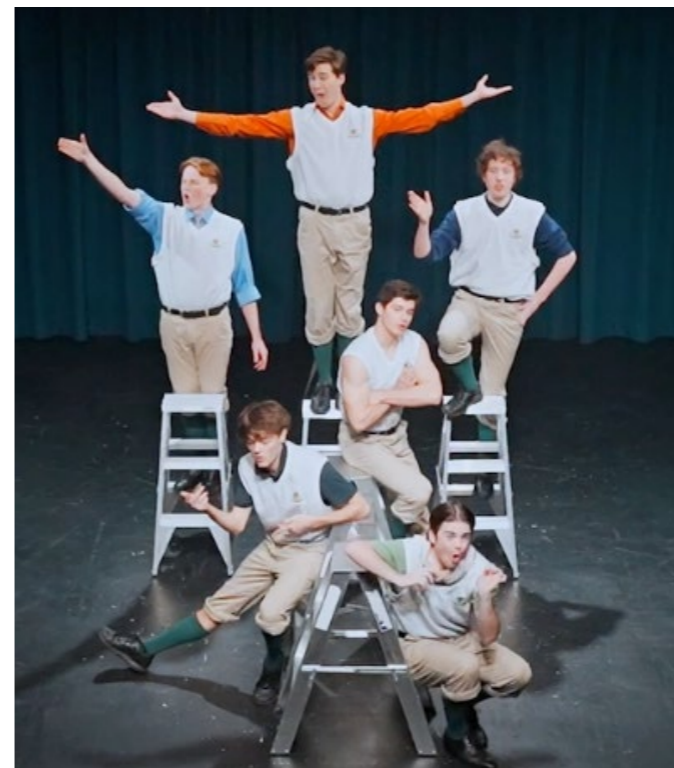

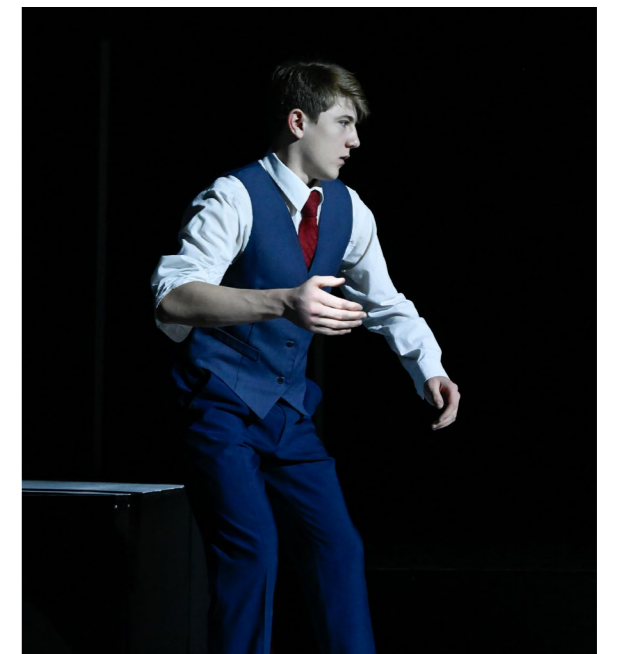
