INDIVIDUAL STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

- Calvin Leung was selected into the Conservatorium of Music Bachelor of Music Performance.
- Laurence Shaw's Visual Arts major work was selected to be included in 'Art Express' the exhibition of 175 selected works from the 9,097 submitted for the HSC.
- HSC Drama students Callum McManus, Liam Hurley and Nicholas Bogard were nominated for the 'On Stage' for their individual pieces which were considered among the best of the 4,697 performances in NSW.
- Nicholas Tkachuk was awarded the Sydney Scholars Scholarship for Combined Commerce and Advanced Studies at USYD.

In the following 21 subjects, students achieved 5% or more above the NSW state mean:

Agriculture, Ancient History, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Chinese Continuers, Drama, Economics, Engineering Studies, English Standard, Geography, IPT, Legal Studies, Mathematics General, Mathematics, Mathematics Extension 1, Modern History, Music 1, PDHPE, Physics, Primary Industries and Senior Science.

Subjects which scored well above the NSW averages were:

Business Studies - 11.62% above NSW average Mathematics 2 unit - 11.40% above NSW average

Music 1 - 11.35% above NSW average **Legal Studies -** 10.54% above NSW average (our first HSC cohort in this subject)

In a total of 14 subjects, 100% of students achieved in the top 20% of NSW.


