The Principal, Rector, staff, parents and community of Saint Ignatius' College Riverview congratulate the Higher School Certificate Class of 2023 on their academic achievements.

In 2023, 327 students completed examinations for the Higher School Certificate across 55 individual courses, with four of those delivered by external providers.

This cohort saw some extraordinary achievements beginning with a record number of nominations for the 'best of NESA Major Works' displays; nineteen individual nominations for 'OnSTAGE' for Drama, one nomination for 'ENCORE' for Music, three students nominated and two selected for 'ARTEXPRESS' for Visual Arts, and eight nominations, including one selection for 'SHAPE' for Design and Technology and Industrial Technology. Congratulations to all of our major-work creators and their hard-working teachers.

Overall, the College achieved a rank of 69th school in NSW, and our students achieved a total of 299 Band 6/E4 results.

These results are indicative of the perseverance and collaboration which we witnessed develop in the cohort throughout their time at the College.
